Retirement Home Definition

Fire Code Definition

.....means a retirement home regulated under the **Retirement Homes Act, 2010**, regardless of whether it is a **care occupancy** or a **residential occupancy**.





Retirement Homes Act (RHA)

Operator requires a license













Retirement Home Definition (RHA)

Residential Complex or the part of a Residential Complex

- Occupied primarily by persons 65 years of age or older, and
- Occupied/intended to be occupied by at least 6 persons not related to operator,

and

Operator makes at least 2 care services available.





RHA – Care Services

- Administration of a drug
- Assistance with bathing
- Assistance with dressing
- Provisions of a meal

- Assistance with feeding
- Continence care
- Assistance with personal hygiene
- Assistance with ambulation
- The provisions of a dementia care program
- The provision of a skin and wound care program





RHA – Care Services, Cont'd

Any service that a member of the Ontario College of:

- ➤ Physicians and Surgeons provides while engaged in the practice of medicine
- > Nurses provides while engaged in the practice of nursing
- ➤ Pharmacists provides while engaged in the practice of pharmacy






Care and Treatment Occupancy

Occupancy in which persons receive special care <u>and</u> treatment.









Care Occupancy Definition

means an **occupancy** in which special care is provided by a facility, directly through its staff or indirectly through another provider, to residents of the facility......





- (a) who require special care because of cognitive or physical limitations, and
- (b) who, as a result of those limitations, would be incapable of evacuating the **occupancy**, if necessary, without the assistance of another person.





Care Occupancy as Residential Occupancy

A care *occupancy*may be classified as a
Group C *major occupancy*

Care Occupancy as Residential Occupancy

- Occupants live as a single housekeeping unit in a *suite*,
- Sleeping accommodation provided for not more than 10 persons, and,
- Not more than 2 occupants require assistance in evacuation in case of an emergency.
