EMERGING ISSUES AND MINISTRY INITIATIVES

OASIS COMMUNICATIONS AND GOVERNMENT RELATIONS SUPPORT

OASIS is pleased to announce that Counsel Public Affairs (Counsel) will be working with us to assist in the development of a government relations plan. Priorities were identified by OASIS impacting its members, individuals and families and how we can more successfully advocate with the provincial government on behalf of the developmental sector.

A key milestone will be the Provincial Budget on April 11 and OASIS will provide feedback to members on any potential impacts soon after it is released.

LABOUR RELATIONS

A discussion was held with the Ministry on the topic of coordinated bargaining in follow-up to the November Information Session in late January. PROVINCIAL NETWORK

The Provincial Network 'Moving On Inclusion & Citizenship Strategy Working Group' continues to meet and are in the process of drafting a budget proposal. A discussion will be requested with the ADM around this.

Dr. Yona Lunsky provided a briefing on a new report released February 2019: Addressing Gaps in the Health Care Services Used by Adults with Developmental Disabilities in Ontario. The OASIS President, Darren Connolly forwarded a thank you letter on behalf of OASIS and its member agencies. Bryan Keshen, Supporting ED, The Housing Work Group, continues to keep their fingers on the pulse of the housing activities as was endorsed by the OASIS board and as part of the Bilateral housing agreement.



Materials have been submitted to the Minister and discussions are underway. This is a positive sign that the DS sector has made a huge impact and is being considered in developing the implementation plan. Given that most housing initiatives go through municipal and regional housing authorities, it is incumbent on members to continue to work on this and follow up with local councilors, Mayors and MPP's to support the DS sector being part of the provincial housing implementation plan. The work group will follow up with practical recommendations once the provincial budget is approved and the direction on housing is clarified
