Most of our efforts of recent date have been in preparing our response to the Gender Wage Gap Steering Committee (GWGSC) after having met with them on January 12, 2016. Bob Butella our OASIS GWGS Committee Chair, Donna Marcaccio our OASIS Pay Equity Committee Chair , Ann Kenney VP OASIS Volunteer, Michelle Marshall VP OASIS ED and I met with the GWGS and were instantly impressed with both the scope of their mission and their sincere interest in seeing not only our most pressing issues resolved through recommendations that they are able to make directly to the Premier but also, their expanded understanding of many of the issues faced by women in our sector and women with an intellectual disability who are supported in our agencies. The conversation lasted for one and one half hours and was very positive and up-beat. Their time lines to conclude their activities and forward their recommendations are such that we will be able to have a comprehensive fulsome report in their hands that will enable them to capture all of our many challenges with respect to wages, up-ward mobility, staff retention, professional designations and a host of other challenges.

The Budget Finance Committee is once again touring the province looking for input into suggestions for the 2016 Province of Ontario budget. We were fortunate to be able to provide a preliminary report to David Ferguson Chair of the OASIS Labour Relations Committee, CEO of OACPDD, in his presentation to the committee in Ottawa. OASIS has asked to make a formal verbal presentation to the committee in Toronto and in any event, will present our written report.

The OASIS Labour Relations Committee Information Session of January 20th at the Holiday Inn, Toronto International Airport was an immense "sold out" event that garnered significant interest and overflow participation. The topics included Health and Safety and the great work OASIS has done in partnering with PSHSA to bring to our website a host of interactive programmes designed to help agencies and their staff meet those requirements.
