While we are pleased that the strikes at some of our member agencies have been settled, we are extremely concerned at the process of the settlement and the effect that such a settlement has on other member agencies in particular and the developmental services sector in general.

We are further concerned that the settlements were <u>not</u> negotiated by both parties involved in the dispute, and we are wondering how this will affect those agencies currently involved in negotiations and the next round of negotiations.

With the recent settlements the wage gap has increased – notwithstanding the recent additional agency allocations!

This matter requires an urgent response from the Ministry and to this end we request an immediate meeting with you and your staff preferably within the next 72 hours. We would be prepared to travel to Ottawa, if necessary.
