The next meeting of the OASIS Board of Directors will be hosted by member agency Corbrook Awakening Abilities in Toronto on December 4-5, 2013. Ottawa-Carleton Association for Persons with Developmental Disabilities (OCAPDD) Board member Jim Smith will be presenting an outline of the Australian Disability Insurance Scheme, including the advocacy process used to bring it to fruition.

On November 13th, OASIS Board representatives met with Karen Chan, the newly appointed Assistant Deputy Minister of the Community & Developmental Services Division of the Ministry, where we shared information about our Operating Pressures Survey report.

Thank you to the Provincial Network for facilitating a great Communications Day on November 20th in Toronto. We look forward to receiving the roll up of the information so that we can incorporate the data into the creation of our Key Messages.

The Labour Relations Committee Information Session on November 21st in Toronto was very well attended. Presentations were given on Pay Equity, the Operating Pressures Survey results, the MOL & PSHSA Initiative, Labour Relations Secretariat Employer Tools, and Shared Leadership.
